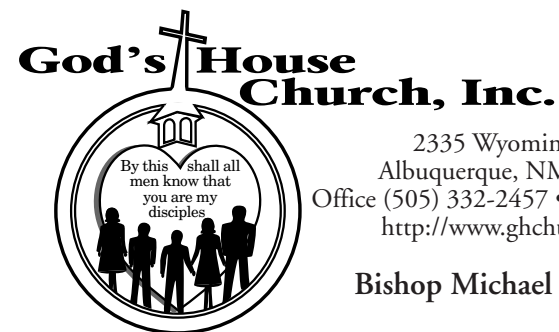

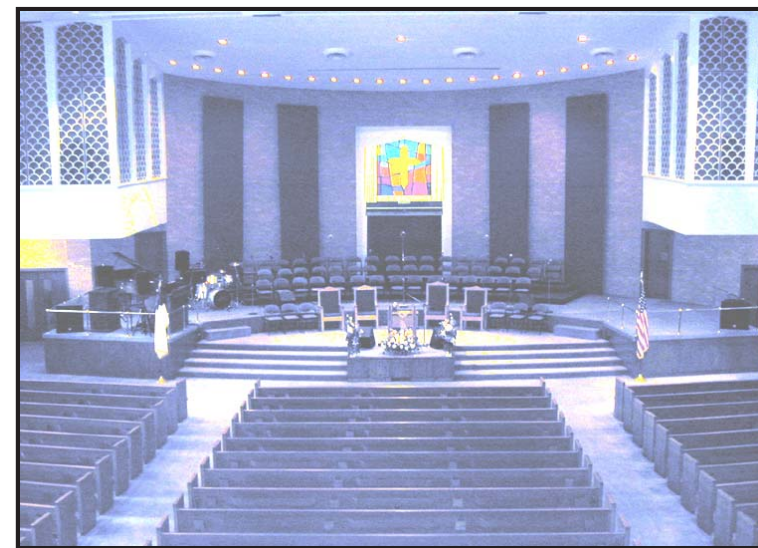

Philippians 1:15-26

SOME indeed preach Christ even of envy and strife; and some also of good will:

16 **The one preach Christ of contention, not sincerely, supposing to add affliction to my bonds:**

17 **But the other of love, knowing that I am set for the defence of the gospel.**

18 **What then? notwithstanding, every way, whether in pretence, or in truth, Christ is preached; and I therein do rejoice, yea, and will rejoice.**

19 **For I know that this shall turn to my salvation through your prayer, and the supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ,**

20 **According to my earnest expectation and my hope, that in nothing I shall be ashamed, but that with all boldness, as always, so now also Christ shall be magnified in my body, whether it be by life, or by death.**

21 **For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain.**

22 **But if I live in the flesh, this is the fruit of my labour: yet what I shall choose I wot not.**

23 **For I am in a strait betwixt two, having a desire to depart, and to be with Christ; which is far better:**

25 **And having this confidence, I know that I shall abide and continue with you all for your furtherance and joy of faith;**

26 **That your rejoicing may be more abundant in Jesus Christ for me by my coming to you again.**
